

Dear Tenant,

Our building is now part of recycLA, an exciting new public private partnership that for the first time in the history of the City of Los Angeles offers efficient waste and recycling services. recycLA provides a number of benefits including 24/7 customer service, field staff for education/outreach, and recycling services. It also provides clean fuel trucks that will improve air quality and will ultimately help Los Angeles get closer to achieving zero waste. What's more, the new program helps us meet the state recycling requirements under AB341.

Universal Waste Systems (UWS) is providing us with a black container for trash, which goes to the landfill, and a blue container for recycling that is taken to a local recycling facility. Under the new program, containers cannot be overfilled (lids must fully close) and blue containers must not be contaminated with non-recyclable materials, such as food, napkins, chip bags, plants, wood, etc. If we fail to follow these guidelines, our building may be subject to financial penalties.

How you can help:

1. Recyclables can be placed directly into the blue recycling container or can be bagged. Always bag shredded paper and plastic shopping bags.



2. Follow the recycling guidelines located on the blue container or poster.



3. Make sure containers are **NOT OVERFILLED**.
